

Worlds largest container ship visited Hamburg the first time

The HMM Algeciras – the worlds largest container ship – visited the port of Hamburg the first time on June 7th, 2020. Until departure on June 10th, 2020 8500 container / 13.600TEU were discharged and loaded at the HHLA Container Terminal Burchardkai (CTB). On it’s way to Asia the next stop will be in Antwerp. ECU moved containers inbound and outbound on This ship too.

The HHLA is pleased that the investment into new technology and storage capacity have been worth the effort and the new big container ships will visit the terminal on a regular schedule. HMM is a always welcomed guest at the port of Hamburg for the last 30 years and this regular ships arrivals will underline the excellent economic relationship between Hamburg and South Korea / Busan. The HMM Algeciras is the new flagship of the South Korean shipping company HMM and the first of twelve container ship which will be delivered to HMM within the next month.
